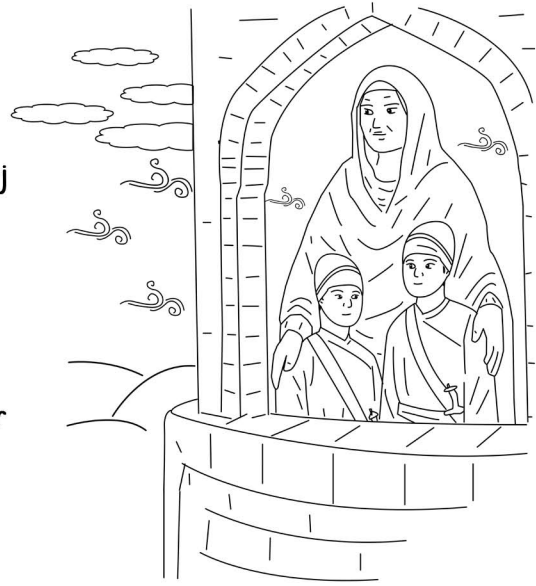


Chote Sahibzaade - The Cold Tower
