

Chamkaur Sahib - Sahibzaada Baba Jujhar Singh Ji

The battle of Chamkaur carried on and the news of Baba Ajit Singh Ji's Shaheedi had spread. Hearing the news of their brother's bravery Baba Jujhar Singh Ji also wished to enter the battlefield.

At the age of 14, Baba Jujhar Singh Ji asked for the blessings of their father Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji and asked for permission to enter the battlefield. They also said "Please don't say I am too young, I am your Son and a Khalsa, and I shall die fighting whilst thinking of you in my heart."



Giving their son eternal blessings Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji sent Baba Jujhar Singh Ji into the battlefield with 5 Singh's, two of these Singh's were Bhai Himmat Singh Ji and Bhai Sahib Ji Singh, (two of the Panj Pyareh, who gave their head to Guru Ji on Vaisakhi 1699).

Baba Jujhar Singh Ji decided to attack the Mughal force who were showing the most hate. The Mughals couldn't attack Baba Jujhar Singh Ji because they were still in shock from Baba Ajit Singh Ji's great skills.

Baba Jujhar Singh Ji and the 5 Singh's showed great power that they injured hundreds of Mughal Soldiers whilst some of the soldiers ran away from the battlefield!

The Singh's created a circle in the battlefield facing the Mughals. The soldiers were scared to go near the circle because they knew they will get attacked.
