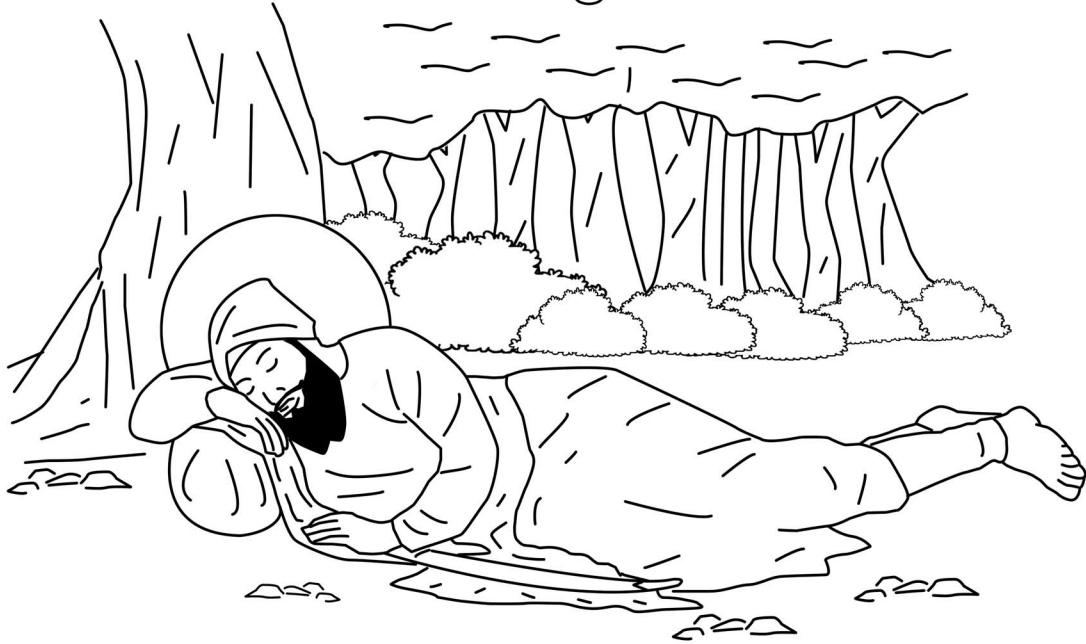


Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji - Machhiwara
